## **CHRIS'S CORNER**

CVE's procedure for setting up Decontamination stations when running water is not present:

Employees exiting containment through a decontamination station are required to wash their hands with running water and soap. All decontamination stations are required to have a place for employees to wash their hands with running water that is collected and disposed of properly.

In the event that running water is not available employees may use a Hudson Pump Sprayer filled with clean water. The Hudson Sprayer must be capable of holding a minimum of one gallon of water for this purpose. All Hudson Sprayers used for washing must be properly labeled in a way that allows for easy identification. Soap must be placed near Hudson sprayer to allow employees to adequately wash themselves of contaminants. A 5-gallon bucket or container must also be available to collect all wastewater that has been used for cleaning. Wastewater is to be disposed of properly and in accordance with all OSHA and DTSC regulations.
