The application also includes tools to help identify and diagnose potential heat related illnesses based on symptoms you or your coworkers may experience. It also outlines proper first aid procedures to follow if someone begins showing signs of heat illness, ensuring a prompt and informed response. Using this app is a simple but effective way to stay aware, stay prepared, and help protect yourself and others from heat related hazards on the job!
